

Approval of the Minutes of the September 4 Meeting


Pr Harris MOVED annroval of the minutes of the Sentember 4 meeting Dr Darvennes

## **Review of Freshman Progress Reports**

Professor Tolbert provided a brief history of the Freshman Progress Report, which began as the Midterm Progress Report in 1995 and which called for periodic reviews by the Council. Information distributed prior to the meeting indicated a rise in the number of faculty reporting to the current level of about 76 percent. Dr. O'Connor MOVED to continue the Freshman Progress Report as it is, and Mr. Hughes SECONDED the motion. It was clarified that the motion did not include a time limit. The motion CARRIED by a unanimous vote.

Professor Tolbert stated that this issue is over, but the issue of how to be more assistive to first-year students will be brought to the Council at a later meeting.
