- 4. Campus Safety Briefing Tony Nelson
 - a. Per TBI report, only 76 crimes were report ed on campus during 2021. This is the lowest reported crime rate TTU has seen.
- 5. Status of EHS Projects Rob DeCheske
 - a. Emergency Operation Plan is with the President's Office awaiting signature.
 - b. A tornado drill was performed on camp us on 2/21/22. According to reports from Rob DeCheske, Faculty and Staffparticipation was subpar. EHS will be doing more drills in the future and will be working with University Policy on emergency preparedness drills and discussing with Human Resources avenues for accountability for annual compliance and safety training.
