

M.S. in Computer Science: Graduate Admission Requirements

(Revised Fall 2023)

Applicants for admission to the MS program offered by the Computer Science (CS) Department are expected to have earned a BS degree in computer science or a related field from an approved program. The admission decision is based on multiple criteria drawn from the following items:

Undergraduate (BS) GPA and the academic institution attended.

General Test (GRE) scores with Quantitative greater than or equal to 50%; Verbal greater than or equal to 33%; Analytical Writing greater than or equal to 33%. A GRE is not required for Computer Science MS program applicants if their undergraduate degree is from a U.S. - based institution.

Three letters of recommendation that demonstrate strong evidence for success in the graduate program.

Availability of appropriate faculty to serve as research advisor(s).
