Scales: All major scales (two octaves where practical)

Prepared: Two contrasting selections, one technical and one lyrical

- Examples of solos: Any Mozart Horn Concerto, Richard Strauss Concerto #1, Franz Strauss Concerto, Hindemith Sonata, Heiden Sonata, Beethoven Sonata, Franz Strauss Nocturne, Saint-Saens Romance, Elizabeth Raum Romance for Horn and Piano, selections from *LIFT: Solos for horn by black* composers (Cimarron Music Press 2023)
- Examples of etudes: Kling 40 Studies for Horn, Shoemaker Legato Etudes for French Horn, Lizzie Davis
  Around the Horn, Kopprasch Sixty Selected Studies for Horn, Matosinhos 12 Jazzy Etudes for Horn (Book 1)
- You are not limited to the examples of solos and etudes above, but be sure to choose something that will best allow you to succeed

- Examples of Solos: Arutunian-Concerto; Haydn-Concerto; Hummel-Concerto; Kennan-Sonata; Hindemith-Sonata; Clarke or Arban-
