How can I qualify to pay in-state fees at Tennessee Technological University?

In general, you must be able to prove that you live in the state of Tennessee year-round and intend to take it your home for the foreseeable future, regardless of your academic status. You must be able to prove intent and domicile by providing the appropriate supplemental documentation.

What if I was transferred by my job to Tennessee? Or what if my parent or spouse was transferred? In most cases, if you can prove you were transferred from one full-time position with a company to another, you will be classified as in-state. The job must be full-time and must be with the same company. In most cases, the same holds true if your parent or spouse was transferred.

start date, hours worked per week, and the likelihood the job will continue throughout the semester, students enrolled in this program will receive in-state rates for at least two consecutive semesters. At the end of the calendar year, the student is then eligible to apply for permanent in-state classification. The same rules and regulations apply to students who have completed the full-time/part-time program for in-state classification.
