75% or better in final semester grades.

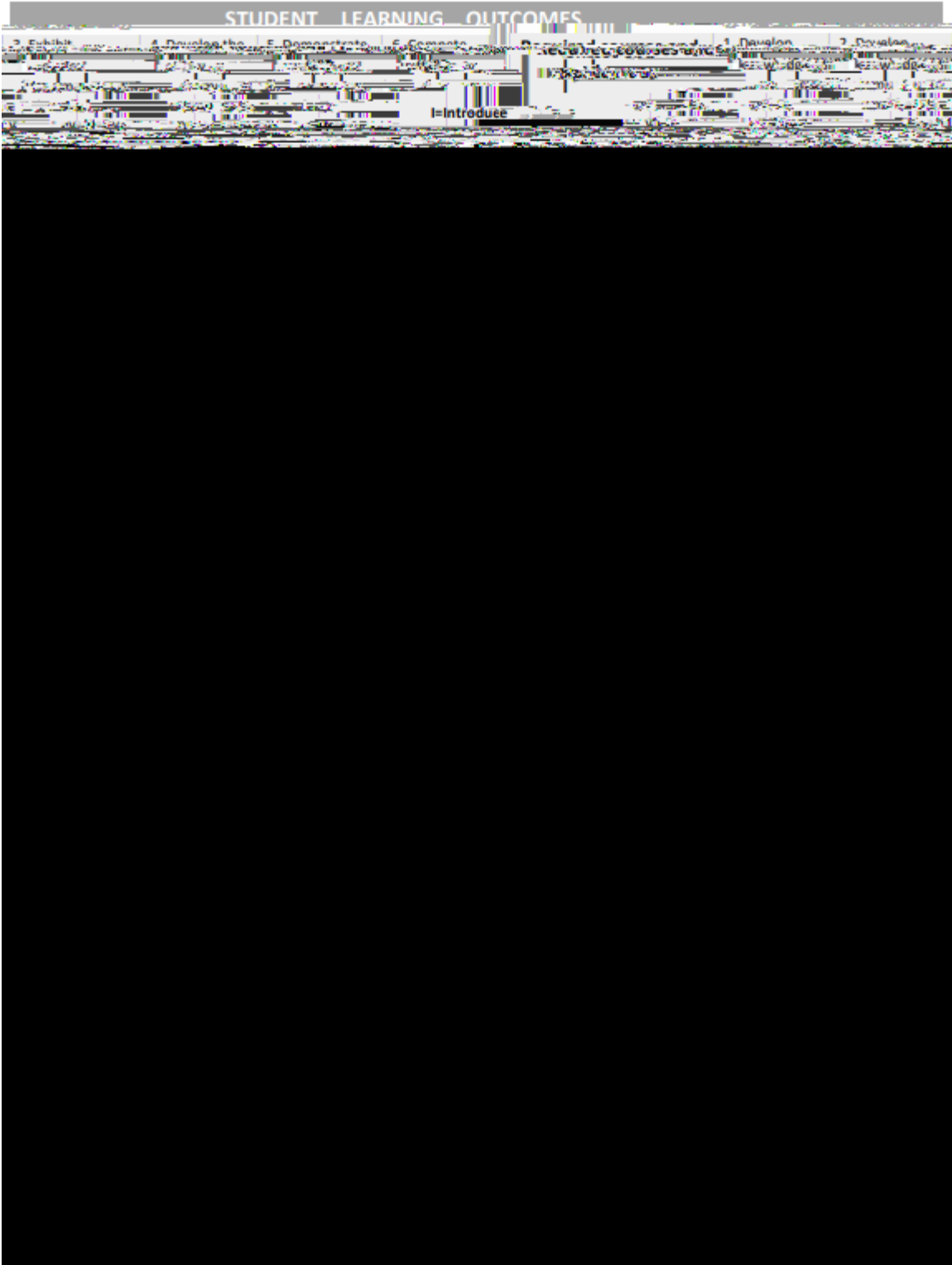
Successful completion (70%) of Art History Survey I and Art History Survey II provides students with the requisite knowledge and understanding.
