Compete alone or on a team

7 minute pitch, 5 minute Q&A

Innovative idea – does not need to be created but must be plausible and feasible

Don't worry about starting a business (unless you want to!)

Thousands in scholarships to be awarded

Have an innovative idea

Can be anything – business, service, app, invention

Actual business not required

#### Form or join a team

Team not required but highly recommended

No idea but want to compete? Find a team

#### Create a business model/plan

- Don't wait til the last minute!

Develop a pitch and practice it!

7 minutes MAXIMUM

Tells the story

Presentation shouldn't be overly complex, is a supplement to your pitch Presentation is NOT required

We will have multiple pitch practices prior to competition!

Use these sessions to get feedback and update your pitch. We will help as much as we can!

- We will provide a laptop for presentations
  - We HIGHLY recommend using PowerPoint widescreen format and sending your file to Andrea akruszka@tntech.edu ahead of time; however
    - Save your presentation as a PDF to make sure it will be compatible, fonts will stay the same, etc.
    - Bring a copy of your presentation on a USB drive backups are always a good idea!
    - We highly recommend NO video!
    - Test your presentation before you compete!

## Finals Judging

There will be 3-5 finalist judges – business and community leaders, entrepreneurs, etc

If a judge has worked with a team, they may still ask questions but they will not submit a rubric for that team

Judges will receive business summary before competition

They will score your pitch based on rubric on FAQ section of website
