Specialist in Education (EdS) Requirements

An EdS program includes competencies needed for a professional specialization. Specializations are offered in the areas of Curriculum and Instruction, Instructional Leadership, and Educational Psychology and Counselor Education. A minimum of 30 semester hours beyond the master's degree, in approved upper-level courses, is required in the EdS program. At least 15 semester hours must be taken in courses numbered at the 7000 level no course below the 6000 level will be counted for credit unless written approval is obtained from the student's advisory committee, the chairperson of the department in which the student is majoring, the dean of the college in which the student is majoring, and the Dean of the College of Graduate Studies. t a m u e o d e e t e t d e d w e e l
