- Whereas,** an individual's fall risk is increased without a step indicator, and,
Whereas, the stairways on Tech's campus have little to no indicators located on its stair-treads, and,
Whereas, individuals with visual impairments or poor depth perception need stairwell tread indicators to safely navigate stairs on Tech's campus, and,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF TENNESSEE TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY THAT

SECTION 1: THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF TENNESSEE TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY SHALL ENACT THE FOLLOWING:

- Section 2:** Each stairwell on Tech's campus will be outfitted with hi-contrast edge highlighters positioned flush with the tread edge.
- Section 3:** Routine maintenance will be performed when highlighter tape is peeling, torn, or otherwise removed.
- Section 4:** This Bill shall take effect immediately upon passage by the Student Government Association, the welfare of the students requiring it.


